Overview

- Temporary, Full-time: 35hrs / week (typically Sunday-Thursday)

Responsibilities

Youth Worker (Ages 12-18)

- Attend, plan, and lead the weekly youth gatherings & activities both small and large that will provide opportunities to engage with teenagers in the community at large regardless of abilities, ethnicity, gender, orientation or socio-economic background.
- Connect with youth who are helping and leading at Kids Arts Camp

- Build and maintain relationships with youth outside of ministry times as appropriate.
- Communicate weekly with parents and youth using digital technology email, Instagram, etc. to ensure that youth are aware of activities.
- Prepare materials for the Fall kick-off event and Fall retreat event.
- Create and lead a preteen open house to invite Gr. 6's to attend the mid-programs.
- Design and lead a 4-week biweekly bible study for youth.

Young Adults' Worker (Ages 18-30)

- Build a digital engagement plan for spiritual formation for Young Adults.
- Attend and lead (when appropriate) the summer schedule for Young Adults Ministry.
- Build and maintain relationships with key Young Adults and encourage them to get involved in the Young Adults Network
- Assist in planning the monthly Table Gatherings/Events for the Young Adults for Fall season.
- Identify build and lead a "serve initiative" that will engage the Young Adults in tangibly serving the local community during the summer.
- Design and lead a 4-week bi-weekly bible study for young adults.

Supervision & Mentorship

- Meet weekly with the Youth Leader & Young Adult Leader to talk through a plan for the week and outline key objectives.
- 1 HR of individual meeting with Youth Leader or Young Adult Leader to work through mentoring material as provided and engage in personal growth.
- Develop relationships with the rest of the staff team through Tuesday morning meetings.
- Supervises leaders and builds relationships within the leadership of the Young Adult Network and the Youth Network.
